

Due to the generous support of parents and friends of the All Saints School community, we have started our summer construction project. This endeavor encompasses a fivefold renovation, which includes the following:

- New music room on the south side of the building, which will include a new sloped metal roof and a covered outdoor entry. The music classroom space will increase to approximately 800 square feet.
- Gutting and renovation of the school office. Included will be a new reception area, workspace area, and offices for our Administrative Assistant, Secretary, and Principal (with windows!).
- A bioswale outside of our art room to provide better playground drainage and to offer the opportunity for a planting area of native grasses and flowers.
- Fencing project around the entire school grounds and new rolling gates. This project is funded through a matching grant, with the Archdiocese of Portland paying for half of the project.
- Two new bathrooms in the faculty lounge and a new maintenance closet.

Incorporating all of these projects together gives All Saints the opportunity to provide for the needs of the school and to facilitate a bidding process that incorporates a “one stop shopping” approach. Thus, the comprehensive project will be \$170,000, paid for with cash on hand.
